

## How to Use Live Homework Help

- 1) Go to [www.nashualibrary.org](http://www.nashualibrary.org)
- 2) Click on the box that says "Live Homework Help."
- 3) Click on "Live Homework Help" on the left side of the page.
- 4) If you are not using a library computer, enter the last five digits of your library card number.
- 5) For Spanish, click "En Español."
- 6) Select your grade level and subject.
- 7) Click "Connect."

In about a minute, you'll be connected to a tutor, and you can start your session in the Online Classroom.

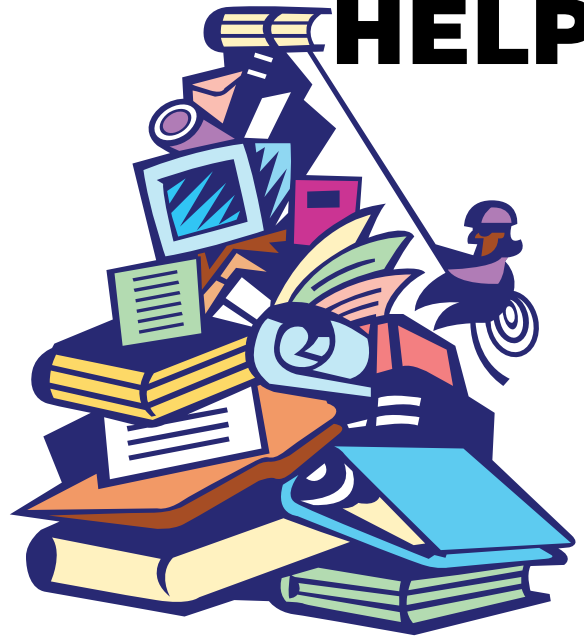

Tutors are certified teachers, college professors, professional tutors, or graduate school students from across the country who have been hired by Tutor.com, the provider of Live Homework Help. Tutors with expertise in math (including algebra, geometry, and calculus), science (including earth science, biology, chemistry, and physics), social studies, and English composition are available. The tutors guide students through the problem-solving process; they do not give out the answers.

Get free homework help on the Internet by using our Live Homework Help tutoring service. Live Homework Help connects students from grade 4 through introductory college level to expert tutors in math, science, social studies, and English. Spanish-speaking tutors are available in math and science.

**How It Works**  
Using their library card numbers, students log on from computers at home and enter the grade level and subject they need help in. (When using Live Homework Help on library computers, no library card is needed.) Immediately, they are connected to a tutor in an Online Classroom. Students and tutors communicate through controlled chat and an interactive white board in the Online Classroom. They can share educational Web sites and send computer files, such as essays, back and forth for review.
